Plaintiff, Securities and Exchange Commission (the "Commission"), by and through its counsel of record, and Charles D. Scoville ("Scoville") through his counsel of record, respectfully submits this Stipulated Motion to Continue Deadline to Respond to Motion to Dismiss (Doc. No. 70).

Defendant Charles D. Scoville ("Scoville") filed the Motion to Dismiss on January 25, 2017. Pursuant to Local Rule 7-1(b)(3)(A), the Commission's response would be due 28 days

after filing. On February 6, 2017, this Court granted the Parties Stipulated Motion to Continue Deadline to Respond to Motion to Dismiss (Doc. No. 74).

On March 28, 2017, the Court issued its ruling on the Commission's Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Scoville's Motion to Set Aside Receivership (the "Pending Motions") and immediately certified it for appeal (Doc. No. 79).

On April 14, 2017, Scoville filed his Notice of Interlocutory Appeal. Because many of the bases relied upon by Scoville in his Motion to Dismiss are currently at issue in his Appeal, it is in the interests of judicial efficiency for the Commission to wait until the Tenth Circuit publishes its opinion before responding to Scoville's Motion to Dismiss.

The Commission therefore respectfully requests that the Court continue the deadline for the Commission to respond to the Motion to Dismiss until 28 days after the matter is remanded by the Tenth Circuit.
