Before the court is the *Receiver's Ex Parte Motion Seeking an Order to Show Cause Why Charles D. Scoville Should Not Be Held in Contempt*. [Docket 128]. The court GRANTS the motion and ORDERS Mr. Scoville to file a brief showing cause why he should not be held in contempt of court for violating the court's *Preliminary Injunction* [Docket 80] and *Amended Order Appointing Receiver* [Docket 81], later revised in the *Second Amended Order Appointing Receiver* [Docket 120].
